

DEMENTIA

What is Dementia?

Dementia is an umbrella term for a range of progressive conditions that affect the brain.

Each type of dementia stops a person's brain cells (neurones) working properly in specific areas, affecting their ability to remember, think and speak.

Doctors typically use the word "Dementia" to describe common symptoms such as memory loss, confusion, and problems with speech and understanding that get worse over time.

Common signs and symptoms

Memory problems

- Increasing forgetfulness
- Difficulty retaining new information
- Getting lost in places that used to be familiar
- Struggling with names
- Misplacing things frequently

Cognitive ability

- difficulty understanding time and place, eg getting up in the middle of the night to go to work, even if they're retired
- difficulty with choosing what to buy and paying when shopping
- struggling with decision-making and reasoning
- loss of interest in activities they used to enjoy
- restlessness, eg pacing, fidgeting and trying to leave the house

Communication

- struggling to find the right words
- repeating themselves often
- difficulty making and following conversation
- difficulty reading and writing
- becoming quieter and more withdrawn

- loss of interest in socialising
- loss of confidence
- changes in personality and behaviour
- mood swings, anxiety and depression



Risk factors

While age is the biggest factor in developing dementia, there are 12 'modifiable risks' – in other words, risks that could potentially be reduced through people's lifestyle choices. These are:

- physical inactivity
- smoking
- high alcohol intake
- air pollution
- head injury
- social isolation
- lower levels of education
- obesity
- hypertension (high blood pressure)
- diabetes
- depression
- hearing impairment

<u>Types of</u> <u>Dementia</u>

There are over 200 subtypes of dementia. Each type stops a person's brain cells (neurones) working properly in specific areas, affecting their ability to remember, think and speak.

- Alzheimer's disease
- Vascular dementia
- Lewy body dementia
- Frontotemporal dementia
- Mixed dementia

RECIPE TIME

Apple Muffin

Ingredients

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- ¼ cup white sugar
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- ½ teaspoon ground cinnamon
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 1 cup milk
- 1 large egg, beaten
- ¼ cup butter, melted
- 1 cup apple peeled, cored, and chopped

Glaze (optional)

- 3/4 cup confectioners' sugar
- 2 to 3 teaspoons milk
- 1 teaspoon butter, melted
- 1/8 teaspoon vanilla extract
- Dash salt



- Stir together flour, sugar, baking powder, cinnamon, and salt.
 Stir together milk, egg, and butter in a separate bowl. Stir egg mixture into flour mixture just until combined. Fold in chopped apples. Spoon batter into prepared muffin cups.
- Bake in the preheated oven until a toothpick inserted into centre of muffins comes out clean, 20 minutes.
