Ingredients

- 400g new potatoes
- 2 tbsp olive oil
- 8 asparagus spears, trimmed and halved
- 2 handfuls cherry tomatoes
- 1 tbsp balsamic vineger
- 2 salmon fillets
- handful basil leaves

Total cooking time:

Prep: 20 mins Cook: 50 mins

Serves: 2

Method

STEP 1

• Preheat oven to 200°C (fan) / Gas 7

STEP 2

 Tip potatoes and 1 tbsp olive oil into an ovenproof dish, then roast the potatoes for 20 mins until starting to brown.

STEP 3

 Add the asparagus into the potatoes and return to the over for 15 mins.

STEP 4

 After the 15 mins, add the cherry tomatoes, vinegar and nestle the salmon amongst the vegetables. Drizzle with remaining olive oil and return to the over for a final 10-15 mins until the salmon is cooked.

STEP 5

• Scatter over the basil leaves and serve up everything straight from the oven dish!
